## To be held at the Western Youth Centre Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2017

- 2. Hall will be open on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> November: 2pm for Helpers setting up the hall Plants being brought to the hall to be exhibited by members 4pm to 5.30pm
- 3. All exhibits must be staged and the hall cleared by 6pm on Friday.
- 4. All plants to be exhibited are to be placed in the space provided and not touched after being placed

On the Show Bench. (No grooming or brushing of plants). There is an area for grooming plants.

- 5. All exhibits to be named and placed with their entry card provided.
- 6. No supports or other aids are permitted on the Show Bench.
- 7. No plants to be sold at the Show except at the Plant Trading Table, or Show plants at the Sales Table.
- 8. All members must leave the Show Hall before judging commences. Judges, Stewards and
  - Award Officials only will be permitted in the Show Hall during judging.
- 9. Judging will commence at 8am on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> November.
- 10. All plants exhibited in classes 1 to 17 inclusive must be Specimen plants, i.e. single crown plants,
  - Unnamed plants will not be accepted.
- 11. Plants may be grown by any method to produce the best specimen.
- 12. All exhibits must be clean, healthy and free from diseases and pests. **If a plant is obviously diseased** 
  - **Or infected, it may be removed** from the Show Hall at the discretion of the Show Manager.
- 13. There is No Limit to the number of plants an exhibitor may enter in each class, but only one of each
  - Variety may be entered in each class, with the exception of Class 19.
- 14. Plants must be the property of the exhibitor three months prior to the date of the show, except
  - In classes 29 to 32.
- 15. Only financial members of 3 months are eligible to exhibit.
- 16. The Society accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to plants.
- 17. The Committee shall have the power to reclassify entries that are not entered in the correct classes,
  - But shall not be held responsible.
- 18. Where Only one entry is received in a class it will not receive a prize unless it receives 75% of

- Points in Open Division or 60% of points in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Division.
- 19. Exhibitor's will be provided with distinguishing Show Bench Cards on the tables to identify the
  - correct place for your plants, Yellow for  $2^{nd}$  Division, Pink for  $1^{st}$  Division, Green for Open Division
  - and Blue for Open to All.
- 20. Aggregate points assessed at 3 points for first, 2 points for second, and 1 point for third in all classes.
- 21. The Champion African Violet and Reserve Champion shall be standard specimen plants.
- 22. Miniatures must not exceed 150mm (6") diameter & Semi-Miniatures must not exceed 200mm (8") diameter.

## 23. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IN ALL CLASSES SHALL BE FINAL.

24. **NB** To be eligible to sell plants on the trading table a member must exhibit a minimum of 1 plant
